

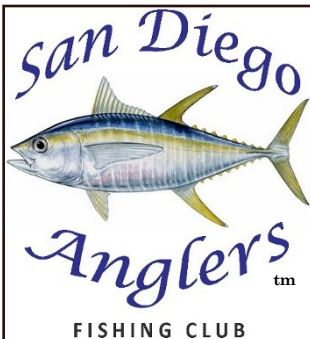

Back in the '40s and '50s, Mexico's Baja peninsula was a rugged, remote area with few roads, and even fewer tourists. Gil Powell was one of these hearty souls who fell in love with the area.

Around 1950, Gil found and purchased a 300-acre piece of paradise located on the beach just south of Buena Vista. Gil was continually going off to Africa to shoot movies - hence the locals gave him the nickname "El Leonero", which roughly translates to "The One Who Knows Lions".

After Gil's death in 1974, Rancho Leonero languished for a number of years until John Ireland stumbled upon it in 1979.

In 1984, John Ireland started construction of the original five rooms of what was to become "The Inn at Rancho Leonero". The original ranch house became the bar and office for the current resort. In 1986, the Inn opened to its first guests.

From this inauspicious birth (in 1986 John had 1 cruiser with an Oar-powered shore boat, the resort has grown to become arguably the best facility on the East Cape.

In 1989, John added a fleet of fast bullet cruisers. In 1990, the second wing of 6 additional rooms were completed. In 1991, the pool and the first of the super pangas were added. In 1992, the first 6 fabulous bungalows were finished, and in 2000 a new 2-story complex was added.

MAY 2nd thru June 2nd, 2019

PAGE 1 OF 2

- The official starting time of the tournament is **12:01 am on Thursday, May 2nd, 2019**. The official ending time of the tournament is **11:59 pm on Sunday, June 2nd, 2019**.
- Boats may depart prior to the official starting time of the tournament. Boats must depart from and return to any port within the county of San Diego. No tournament fishing is allowed prior to the official tournament starting time. All club tournaments are operated on an honor system.
- The fishing boundaries shall be limited to the waters of the Pacific Ocean within 125 miles of San Diego.
- During the tournament, fishing can be done from any fishing platform, including Sportfishing boats.
- Bait may be caught, purchased, or acquired as available prior to the official tournament starting time. Bait may be kept aboard tournament boats, used or transferred at the discretion of the anglers or skippers throughout the tournament.
- IGFA angling rules will be used for this tournament. Angling rules can be found in the San Diego Anglers Yearbook under General Angling Rules. Anglers are responsible for compliance with all California or Mexican fishing and boating laws and regulations, as applicable.
- Weight Receipts: It is the responsibility of each entrant to submit all weight receipts signed, witnessed, with time/date stamp to the Club Weighmaster no later than **11:59pm June 2nd, 2019**. Weight receipts received after this deadline will be disqualified. Weight receipts can be found on the Club website. Weight receipts can be scanned and emailed to Club weighmaster or submitted via the online form. More than one weight receipt per angler may be submitted.
- Species: Yellowtail.
- Prizes will be awarded in the following Categories: Heaviest Single Yellowtail - 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th and 5th place for adults; 1st, 2nd and 3rd for juniors. There will be no ties in any categories. When two fish of the same weight are submitted, the first fish submitted by date and time is considered the winner.
- All anglers are responsible to stay aware of current weather/sea conditions. Monitor NOAA weather radio for info.
- All tournament anglers must complete, sign and submit a Tournament Entry Form and a COPY OF THEIR CURRENT BOAT INSURANCE POLICY prior to wetting a line in this fishing tournament. Entrants may sign up anytime prior to the tournament starting date and time. The entry forms must be turned in to the locations or persons listed on the back of this form. All entrants in the tournament must be current members in good standing. No guests are permitted for this tournament. Entry forms can be scanned and emailed to Tournament Director with all pertinent signatures, boat insurance info (if applicable), and date/time stamp. By signing the application, Applicant does assume all risks of injury or property damage, and does agree to hold the San Diego Anglers harmless should any injury, death or property damage occur.
- Failure to comply with any of these rules will result in the offending angler's disqualification from the tournament and possible termination of club membership.
- Tournament Angler of the Year points will be awarded for this tournament. There will be **NO** Skipper points awarded for this tournament.

3. Any protest relative to the weight of a fish, manner of weighing, or the manner of catching/landing the fish must be made prior to the fish being removed from the scale. The protest must be made to the Tournament Weighmaster and Tournament Director at that time.
4. Any protest, except weight, must be filed in writing with the Protest Committee no later than 24 hours after the ending time of the tournament. The protest may be filed with any member of the Protest Committee.
5. The San Diego Anglers take no responsibility for personal injury, death, or property damage resulting from any misconduct, negligence, and adverse weather conditions or otherwise, of any persons or its members at sponsored events and tournaments.
6. The San Diego Anglers does not investigate weather or sea conditions, or the possibility of other boating activities, when scheduling its events.
7. By signing this application, the applicant assumes all risks of injury, death, or property damage, and agrees to hold the San Diego Anglers harmless should any injury or damage occur.
