Lyall works as a marine fisheries scientist working to improve management and conservation of marine resources in California. His research combines collaboration, innovation, and quantitative methods to ensure long-term health and sustainability of marine ecosystems, fisheries, and fishing communities. Lyall works collaboratively with multiple stakeholder groups to identify fisheries data gaps, and design and implement research programs to fill these gaps. This allows fisheries managers to make more efficient, informed, and effective decisions.

Prior to the Conservancy, Lyall was a graduate student at Scripps Institution of Oceanography and a National Research Council post-doctoral

fellow at the NOAA Southwest Fisheries Science Center. He developed two large-scale collaborative fisheries research programs in partnership with the commercial and recreational fishing communities, fisheries managers, non-profit representatives, and other fisheries researchers. These programs are now serving as successful models for future fisheries research, and resulted in ongoing improvements to local fisheries conservation efforts. Lyall holds a Ph.D. in marine biology from Scripps Institution of Oceanography, UC San Diego and an M.S. in biology from CSU Long Beach.

Lyall is currently working on: 1) a collaborative red abalone data collection program that will guide the implementation of the first harvest control rules in the statewide California recreational fishery, 2) a manuscript documenting the reduction of protected species bycatch via the development and management of a quota risk pool in the west coast groundfish fishery, and 3) a collaborative program to develop and scale alternative, low-bycatch fishing gear types in the California offshore drift gillnet swordfish fishery.

## San Diego Anglers June 2019 Charters

We have 4 charters scheduled for June; two twilight trips, a 3/4-day trip on the "Vendetta" and a 3/4-day trip on the "San Diego".

The twilight trips are June 14 and the 28th. Both are on Friday evenings out of Seaforth landing in Mission Bay. Cost is \$10 for adults and kids fish for free. Non club members is \$20 per person (space available). Be at Seaforth about 5-5:15 pm to get checked in. Boat departs at 6 pm sharp and returns to the dock about 10-10:30 pm. It is generally really good bass fishing on these trips with a mix of bonito, barracuda and shallow water rockfish after the sun goes down.

The **Sunday, June 16th, "Vendetta"** trip is sold out. If you have not paid, please pay by the next meeting. It is scheduled to go to the islands but you never know with the amount of bluefin that is heading our way at the time of this writing. The yellows have also been pretty good at the islands with some days limits. With limited rod space, we are limited to 4 rods per person on this trip (20-through 40-lb will do the trick).



The Sunday, June 30th, 3/4-day trip on the "San Diego" is also sold out. Looking at the list, most people on this charter have not paid yet, so please pay by the next meeting. The itinerary is the same as the "Vendetta" trip. The target is the islands, but if we have to switch gears because of bluefin, we can certainly do that.

**IMPORTANT NOTICE.** Debbie and I will be gone on our annual trip to the Sierras to go catch trout for 10 days. Where we go has no cell phone access so I will be unavailable for most of the time. I will not get any texts also. (We are buried in the high country!) It will



be impossible to get ahold of me while we are gone, so I am trying to get all the charter stuff put to bed before we take off on the 13th. 


#### PROCEDURE TO APPLY FOR AWARDS:

## Got Bluefin Tuna? Share your carcasses with researchers!

The Highly Migratory Species research team at NOAA's Southwest Fisheries Science Center needs your help collecting gonads (reproductive parts), stomachs, and otoliths from locally-caught tuna. In recent years, large (150-275 lb.) Pacific bluefin tuna (Thunnus orientalis) frequented California. If history repeats itself in 2017, we are asking for your help to collect samples from these large fish.

It is generally accepted that Pacific bluefin tuna only spawn in two regions in the western Pacific (*right*). After hatching, a portion of the young bluefin migrate to the eastern Pacific Ocean to forage and grow. These bluefin usually return to the western Pacific Ocean as they approach sexual maturity at around 3-6 years old (4-6 feet in length). However, in recent years fish that are potentially old enough to be mature have remained in the eastern Pacific for longer than usual, prompting new research and questions. One of our main objectives is to examine gonads from these fish to see if they are mature and determine if they are spawning offshore of Califor nia. While gonads collected so far have not exhibited developed ovaries or any evidence of spawning, we need more samples to be conclusive.

If you would like to share your bluefin tuna carcasses, please keep samples on ice to preserve freshness and contact us as soon as possible to arrange for timely pickup. Any and all samples you provide will improve the quality of our science!
