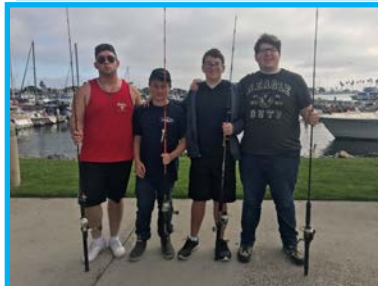
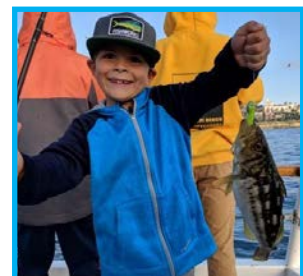
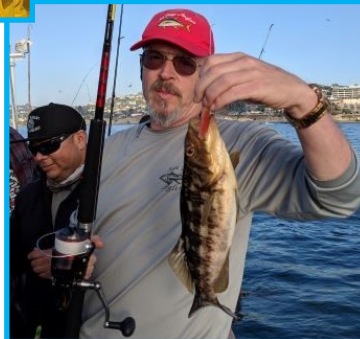
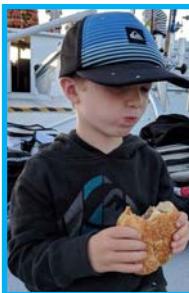
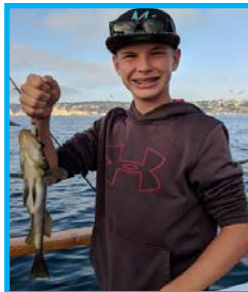
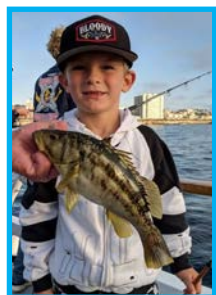
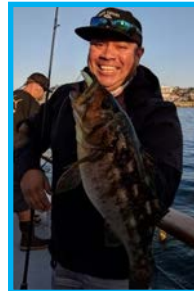
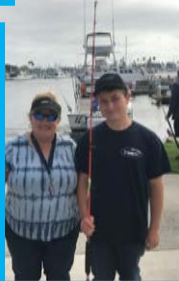
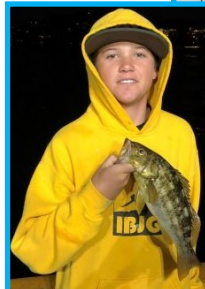
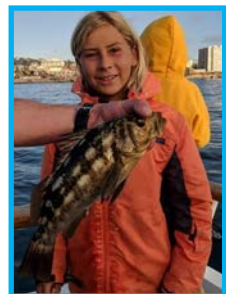


# July 12th, 2019 Twilight Charter

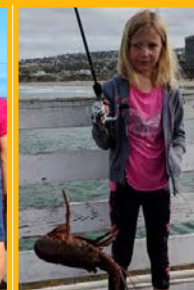
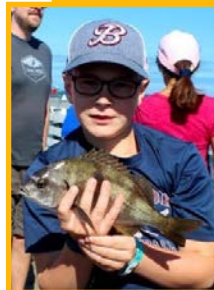

If you have tried to purchase an annual Mexican fishing license recently, you know that there has been an issue as you could not find one. At the time of this writing, the Mexican government had closed its San Diego office that was used by all the landings and tackle shops to purchase annual Mexican fishing licenses, with no explanation. Needless to say, there are no annual Mex fishing licenses to purchase, which has caused a mild panic. (The landings have plenty of one-day licenses they use on the boats). SAC (Sportfishing Association of California) is looking to get it corrected ASAP, but in the meantime, there is a solution if you are looking to purchase an annual license.



Go online to <http://pesca.ebajacalifornia.gob.mx/Pesca/> to purchase an annual license. Cost is about \$39. Just a few tips to make it easier....\*\*\* Click on the American flag to translate the page. \*\*\*You must register, which is easy. \*\*\*When it asks for the area, just choose the top one.\*\*\* When it comes time to pay with your credit card, Choose "MXN" and not "US Dollars", otherwise, the charge will be declined. One more tip: print more than one license, in case you lose or misplace one.

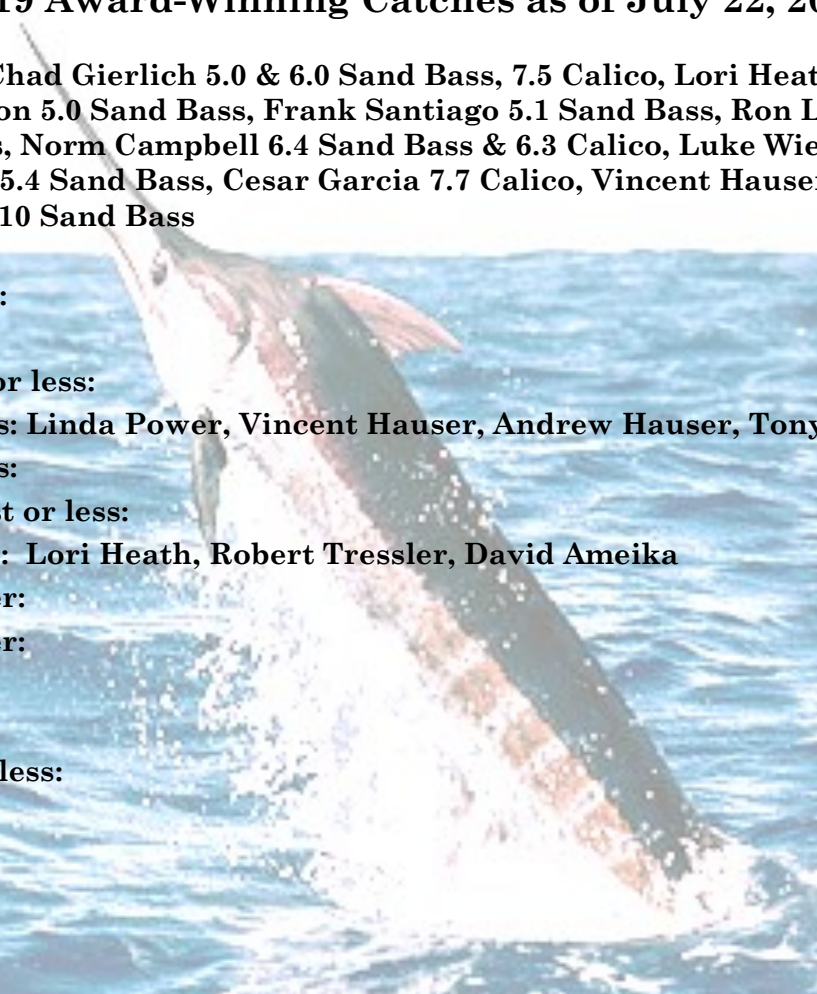

## AUGUST 2019 MONTH LONG IGFA TOURNAMENT RULES AND ENTRY FORM



August 08 thru September 02, 2019

Tournament channel 72

PAGE 1 OF 2

- The official starting time of the tournament is **12:01am on Thursday, August 08, 2019**. The official ending time of the tournament is **08:00pm on Monday, September 02, 2019**.
- Boats may depart prior to the official starting time of the tournament. Boats must depart from and return to any port within the county of San Diego. No tournament fishing is allowed prior to the official tournament starting time. All club tournaments are operated on an honor system.
- The fishing areas of the tournament shall be limited to those waters of the Pacific Ocean within 125 miles of San Diego.
- During the tournament, fishing can be done from any fishing platform, including sportfishing boats.
- Bait may be caught, purchased, or acquired as available prior to the official tournament starting time. Bait may be kept aboard tournament boats, used, or transferred at the discretion of the anglers or skippers throughout the tournament.
- IGFA angling rules will be used for this tournament. Angling rules can be found in the San Diego Anglers Yearbook under General Angling Rules. Anglers are responsible for compliance with all California or Mexican fishing and boating laws and regulations, as applicable.
- Weight Receipts: It is the responsibility of each entrant to submit all weight receipts signed, witnessed, with time/date stamp to the Club Weighmaster no later than **11:59pm September 02, 2019**. Weight receipts received after this deadline will be disqualified. Weight receipts can be found on the Club website. Weight receipts can be scanned and emailed to Club Weighmaster. More than one weight receipt per angler may be submitted.
- Species: All species eligible for San Diego Anglers Angler of the Year standings. All-around Angler Club Points System will apply for winning places to level the playing field. Tournament awards will be presented at the September club meeting.
- Cash prizes based on participation will be awarded in the following categories: **Highest Single Fish Point Total** - 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup> with a 5<sup>th</sup> place free entry for adults; 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> for juniors. There will be no ties in any categories. When two fish of the same weight are submitted, the first fish submitted by date and time is considered the winner.
- All anglers are responsible to stay aware of current weather/sea conditions. Monitor NOAA weather radio for info.
- All tournament anglers must complete, sign and submit a **Tournament Entry Form** and a **COPY OF THEIR CURRENT BOAT INSURANCE POLICY** prior to wetting a line in this fishing tournament. Entrants may sign up any time prior to the tournament starting date and time. The entry forms must be turned in to the locations or persons listed on the back of this form. All entrants in the tournament must be current members in good standing or non-members fishing as a guest of a club member. Entry forms can be scanned and emailed to Tournament Director with all pertinent signatures, boat insurance info (if applicable), and date/time stamp. By signing the application, Applicant assumes all risks of injury or property damage, and agrees to hold the San Diego Anglers harmless should any injury, death or property damage occur.
- Failure to comply with any of these rules will result in the offending angler's disqualification from the tournament and possible termination of club membership.
- Tournament Angler of the Year points will be awarded for this tournament. There will be NO Skipper points awarded for this tournament.

**There will be no food after tournament.**

**ALL ENTRANTS MUST BE MEMBERS OF THE SAN DIEGO ANGLERS IN GOOD STANDING**
