

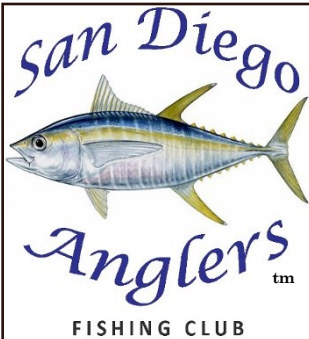

As a boy, Yanni spent all of his free time fishing the Belmont Shores Pier.

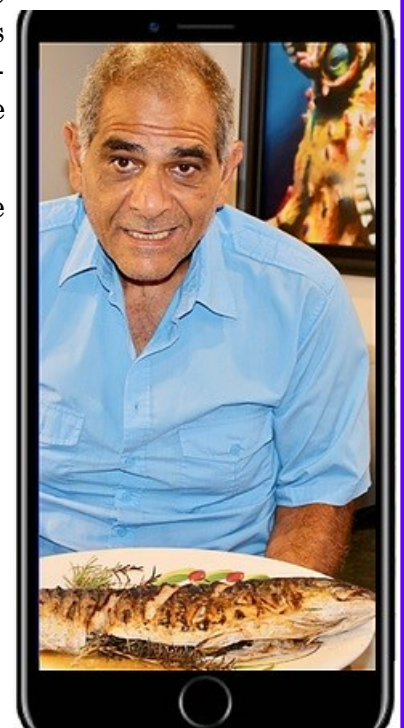
Now, you'll find him jumping into his kayak, fishing for trout, halibut, white sea bass, rockfish and yellowtail up and down the California coast

Club Charters

At the time of this writing, we still do not have a concrete schedule. I will be talking with the skippers at Fred Hall Long Beach in March and hope to have a schedule by the May meeting. We are planning on having pretty much the same schedule as before, but it is completely up to the schedule of the boats.

Penn Mega Raffle

Net proceeds will be used to fund the many projects the Foundation has in store this year. We had one with Daiwa last year and it was a huge success, with Kent Wyatt as our lucky winner. He walked away with 5 Daiwa rod-and-reel combos valued at over \$1500! This is how it works: we will have 5 Penn reels (Fathom 40 2-speed lever drag, Fathom 25N's speed lever drag, Fathom 15 2-speed lever drag, Fathom 15 series II, single speed star drag and a Slammer III 4500 series spinning reel) matched with 5 Penn rods. They are valued at about \$1900!!! And how do you enter, you ask?? With a purchase of a \$10 raffle ticket. You can certainly purchase more than one ticket if you choose!! We will have tickets available for sale at the club meetings, Fred Hall Del Mar and Day at the Docks if necessary. We will be printing about 350 tickets and when they are all sold, we will pull the name at one of the functions, with the profit going to the Foundation. Everyone is a winner! Stay tuned, as of this writing it is still in the final planning stages but we are HOPING to have it at the next meeting (no promises).

Royal Polaris Trip -Foundation Raffle

For those of you that do not know, Ray Broadfoot, as a side job, does the stainless steel galley work on many of the local Sportfishing boats. Part of his payment are vouchers to fish the particular boat. With the boat owners' permission (Frank), Ray has generously donated his 3-day trip voucher (valued at about \$1200) to the Foundation from the Royal. After much deliberation, we decided the best way to utilize it is to do another Mega Raffle at \$10 per ticket. The winner can use the voucher on a trip on a date to be determined (sometime in April); he/she just has to pay the difference if it is more than 3 days. Open Bay Bass - Top 25 Invitational

We had tentatively planned it for April 4, 2020, but we have a scheduling conflict with the Awards Banquet, so we have rescheduled for Sat April 25, 2020, at Shelter Island. For the new members, we invited back the top 25 teams from January's Open Bay Bass Tournament for another San Diego Bay tournament. This is a lures-only tournament and generally is pretty exciting as the lead changes many times as huge, 3-fish limits of bass go across the scale, with everyone competing for the nearly \$1,750 in prize money. I think what is most coveted is the title "King of the Bay" for the next year. If you were in the top 25, we will be contacting you soon with the invitation!

SUSAN JOHNSON MEMORIAL BASS TOURNAMENT

After a long stretch of nice weather, the forecast for February 22, 2020 was calling for a significant chance of rain showers throughout the day. Despite the ominous forecast, a total of 28 anglers (19 men, 2 ladies, and 7 juniors) set out in search of an elusive 3-fish sack of any species of bass from the confines of Mission Bay for the annual Susan Johnson Memorial Bass Tournament. The conditions were clear and calm to start the day, but the storm clouds soon began to build. By around 10 am, the wind picked up and the rain really began to come down! A few participants decided to pack it in, and who could blame them given the tough weather and fishing conditions. Fortunately for those who decided to stay on the water, the storm was relatively short-lived, and by noon the weather cleared up nicely for the remainder of the event. This made the food, drinks, and camaraderie at the weigh-in quite a bit more enjoyable.

The fishing was reported as being tough overall before, during, and after the storm. Only four participants made it to the scales with a legal bass, and Mario Souza was the only angler who weighed more than one fish. This earned him top honors in our kickoff to the 2020 club tournament! Thanks to all who came out and fished or just came out to check out the weigh-in. Hope you see you all at our next tournament in April, when we will be targeting halibut.
