



Charter Report

San Diego 3/4-day on June 27th, 2021

Our first offshore trip of the year had everyone excited in the prospects of catching Bluefin tuna. The trip had originally been booked as an Island trip so we all had our passports, just in case we had to make a change in plans. I had talked to Captain Ryan the day before and he suggested we do get our Mexican paperwork and have the Island plan still on the table as the bluefin were just a few miles outside and if we finished getting limits early, we can jet into the islands and try for yellows and bass.

Ryan is on the water everyday, so I did not quarrel with him at all. Best available fishing is always a good game plan! Captain Matt met us in the morning and after a slight delay in fixing a small electrical issue, we were on our way. Rigging started right away. 20 to 100 lb rigs as we did not know what we were going to encounter as the fish have been from 25 lbs to 150 lbs. Our first stops had the fish settled in at 150 ft below the boat. On a tip from Shane on the "Vendetta" on our trip before, David Ameika bought a few Daiwa Zakana jigs before we left. It was a good idea as he had great luck with those lures on our first stops. "Is Dave hooked up again?" was heard a lot as he raced down the rail with another hookup! As the morning progressed, the Bluefin started to come to the surface and play a little more. Matt said the key to our day was finding a school that would stick to the boat. The day before they drove all day, stopping on school after school that did not want to hang around. Today would be different. The last two schools we stopped on hung around the boat so we could get our limits. The lighter the line and the fresher the bait, the quicker you got a bite. We were lucky as all the fish were in the 20-25 lb class and 20lb test was just perfect. It was about noonish when Capt Matt pulled the plug on our tuna fishing and turned the boat toward the Islands. We had our limits!


We got there in less than an hour, driving by two schools of Bluefin on the way in that on any other day we would have stopped on. We did the obligatory tour, starting at North Island with Capt. Matt sidescanning all the way down the Islands looking for yellows. None to be found. Ugh!! "Lets go catch some bass," he said as he knows we are one of the few charters that loves bass fishing, so we were on our way. As we approached our spot, he commented on hour the wind had switched mid morning coming from the north to now coming from the south as the hurricane off baja was heading our way. He said the anchor job and current would not be optimum but he would do his best.

The chum circle had the bass jumping out of the water before we even set anchor. "This is going to be fun", he said as he grabbed his surface iron rod after the anchor set. You just had to pick your favorite way you wanted to catch: bass, iron, Hookup baits, swim baits, live bait. They were all working. We did not get any huge bass, but we got enough to bring home and make tacos for the family. By the time it was time to go home, the bass were snapping very well. He made the announcement we had run out of time and had to go home, and a chorus of "Nooooo" erupted from the back of the boat. He did not listen and kept pulling the anchor.

We made our way home in flat seas with lots of smiles on our faces. Limits of tuna for everyone and bass for tacos tomorrow night! We would like to thank the captain and crew for another great trip on the "San Diego" and look forward to our trip with them in September. We still have plenty of charters coming up on the "Mission Belle," "Vendetta", "San Diego" and "Liberty." Just stay tuned for the email signups the month before the trip.







Sunday, August 1, thru Sunday, August 22, 2021.

- The official starting time of the tournament is **5:00am on Friday, August 01, 2021**. The official ending time of the tournament is **6:00pm on Sunday, August 22nd, 2021**. * **Entry into the tournament will be accepted until 8:00 PM Friday, August 20, 2021**
- Boats may depart prior to the official starting time of the tournament. Boats must depart from and return to any port within the county of San Diego. No tournament fishing is allowed prior to the official tournament starting time. All club tournaments are operated on an honor system.
- The fishing areas of the tournament shall be limited to those waters of the Pacific Ocean within 125 miles of San Diego.
- During the tournament, fishing can be done from any fishing platform, including Sportfishing boats.
- Bait may be caught, purchased, or acquired as available prior to the official tournament starting time. Bait may be kept aboard tournament boats, used, or transferred at the discretion of the anglers or skippers throughout the tournament.
- IGFA angling rules will be used for this tournament. Angling rules can be found in the San Diego Anglers Yearbook under General Angling Rules. Anglers are responsible for compliance with all California or Mexican fishing and boating laws and regulations, as applicable.
- Weight Receipts:** It is the responsibility of each entrant to submit all weight receipts signed, witnessed, with time/date stamp to the Club Weighmaster no later than **8:00pm Sunday, August 22, 2021**. Weight receipts received after this deadline will be disqualified. Weight receipts can be found on the Club website. Weight receipts can be scanned and emailed to Club Weighmaster. More than one weight receipt per angler may be submitted, but only the largest fish for each species will be scored.
- Species: All species eligible for San Diego Anglers "Angler of the Year" standings.** The All-around Angler Club Points System will apply for winning places to level the playing field. Tournament awards will be presented at the September club meeting.
- Cash prizes, based on participation, will be awarded in the following categories: **Highest Single Fish Point Total** - 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, with a 5th place free entry for adults; 1st, 2nd, and 3rd for juniors. There will be no ties in any categories. When two fish of the same weight are submitted, the first fish submitted by date and time is considered the winner.
- All anglers are responsible to stay aware of current weather/sea conditions. Monitor NOAA weather radio for info.
- All tournament anglers must complete, sign, and submit a Tournament Entry Form and a COPY OF THEIR CURRENT BOAT INSURANCE POLICY prior to wetting a line in this fishing tournament. Entrants may sign up any time prior to the tournament starting date and time. The entry forms must be turned in to the locations or persons listed on the back of this form. All entrants in the tournament must be current members in good standing or non-members fishing as a guest of a club member. Entry forms can be scanned and emailed to Tournament Director with all pertinent signatures, boat insurance info (if applicable), and date/time stamp. By signing the application, Applicant assumes all risks of injury or property damage, and agrees to hold the San Diego Anglers harmless should any injury, death or property damage occur.
- Failure to comply with any of these rules will result in the offending angler's disqualification from the tournament and possible termination of club membership.
- Tournament-Angler-of-the-Year points will be awarded for this tournament. There will be NO Skipper points awarded for this tournament.

There will be no food after tournament.

- The official starting time of the tournament is **06:00 am on Sunday, August 1, 2021**. The official ending time of the tournament is **5:00 pm on Sunday, September 26, 2021. THIS WILL BE A FORK MEASUREMENT RULE TOURNAMENT.**
- Boats may depart prior to the official starting time of the tournament. Boats must depart from and return to any port within the county of San Diego. No tournament fishing is allowed prior to the official tournament starting time. All club tournaments are operated on an honor system.
- The fishing areas of the tournament shall be limited to those waters of the Pacific Ocean within 125 miles of San Diego.
- During the tournament, fishing can be done from any fishing platform, including kayaks, private or sportfishing boats.
- Bait may be caught, purchased, or acquired as available prior to the official tournament starting time. Bait may be kept aboard tournament boats, used, or transferred at the discretion of the anglers or skippers throughout the tournament.
- IGFA angling rules will be used for this tournament. Angling rules can be found in the San Diego Anglers Yearbook under General Angling Rules. Anglers are responsible for compliance with all California or Mexican fishing and boating laws and regulations, as applicable.
- All fish entries photo must be e-mailed to lindevsji@aol.com with an email date/time of no later than 6:00 PM, Sunday, September 26, 2021. Late entries will not be accepted. There must be 2 photos per fish:**

Second Photo: Shall be of the same fish, this time of the "Y" of tail section of the fish so as to be able to read the length of the fish to the nearest 1/8".
Photos that are not in focus enough to be properly read will not be accepted. You will be notified as soon as the photos are reviewed if they are not acceptable.
- Eligible Species: Tuna (Yellow or Blue fin), Dorado, and Yellowtail. Entrants can submit multiple submittals, only the largest single fish of each specie will be counted for that angler.
- Prizes will be awarded in the following categories: **Tuna Class, Dorado Class, Yellowtail Class**- 1st, 2nd, 3rd place for adults; 1st, 2nd, and 3rd for juniors. Measurement Rule Information

The 2021 Earl Asbury Memorial Tournament will be an 8-week event under the SDA Measurement Rule.

All anglers **MUST BE** signed up PROIR TO FISHING. All entry forms must be sent in before 6:00 AM the date of the event

All fish **MUST BE** of legal size to be scored, even if the fish is released. The fish must be photographed against the measuring device as depicted in the diagram below.

All fish must be measured the same way: with the fish lying on its side, on a flat surface. The '0' end of the soft tape at the nose/closed mouth of the fish. The soft tape measure shall be pulled taut (No wrinkles) and run the side centerline of the fish to the "Y" of the tail.

The **photos** of the catch **MUST BE IN FOCUS**. **First Photo** shall show the whole fish, with a clear view of the zero end of the tape is on the nose/closed mouth and where the soft tape measure comes to on the "Y" of the tail and the Angler's Name. The Angler's Name may be written on an index card or the back of your hand, either way it must be legible. **Second Photo** shall be of the "Y" of the tail so as to be able to easily read the soft tape measuring device to the nearest 1/8".

The Photos and Measurement Rule Tournament Fish Report form (Fill out completely for **each species** being entered. Example: Three species, three forms and 6 photos) must be e-mailed to lindseysj@aol.com before the closing deadline, 6:00 PM on Sunday, September 26, 2021.

All length will be determined/confirmed by the tournament director based on photo sent in.

HOW TO MEASURE FORK LENGTH OF CATCH

The **total length** is the maximum length of the fish, from the nose/closed mouth to the "Y" of the tail. With the fish laying on its side, on a flat surface, Place the Zero end of a soft tape measure at the nose/closed mouth. Pull a flexible tape taut (no wrinkles), measure along the side centerline/curve of the fish to the farthest section of "Y" of the tail.



