A little later we moved out of the kelp and caught reds, along with the usual bottom fish, even a lingcod! The juniors were fishing hard for their jackpot and it paid off! Aviril Miller took 1st place with a Red, Wyatt Cargel took 2nd, and Eddie Chavez took third. Each junior received a rod and reel combo and a package of plastics. Success Charter

On August 17th, 11 of us boarded the 65 foot success for a two day tuna trip. Little did we know how of an epic trip this would be. A big thanks goes out to Dwayne as the Charter master, however he was unable to fish on his own charter. Instead, his lovely wife Debbie was on the trip to keep us all in line and she out fished the most of us.

We left the docks at approximately 9 p/m and loaded up our tanks with good size sardines. The baits was not in good shape and only lasted (1) day. We headed south toward the hunting grounds in 2 to 4 foot sea's and we all had a restless night. The fishing was off the hook and we had our yellow fin limits by noon. The Yellow fin weighed in between 15 to 25 lbs. and were caught on 30 lb. fluorocarbon. The hooks that were used were #1 nose hooked and #3/0 belly hooked. The other tip was using dart stile jigs in mackerel on the slide. The top fish went to Tony who landed a 75 lb. blue fin in record time. On Monday night, the skipper was able to procure some bait from the Shogun. This allowed us to fish without cutting the trip short.

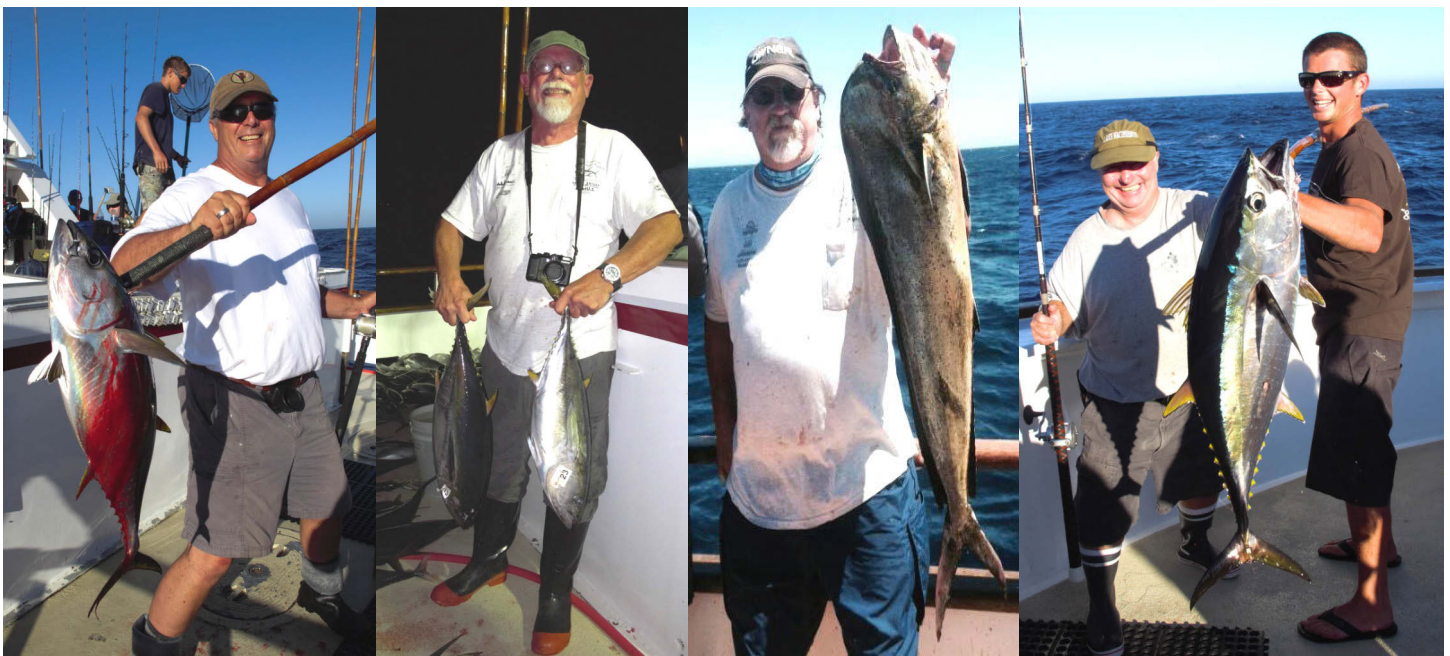

We had our two day limits of yellow fin and we released some very fine grade of tuna to be hunted at another time. I cant say enough about the skipper and crew of the Success. They were very polite and well seasoned. They provided us with tips and insights that improved our catch ratio. Again a big thanks goes out to Dwayne and Debbie for planning this trip. San Diego Anglers 1.5 Day Eclipse Charter

With Hurricane Marie off the coast of Southern California, the big concern was how choppy the seas would be on our annual charter. Well, the fish gods were on our side as the ride out on Wednesday night was great with hardly any swells to speak of. So after getting some bait at the bait barge it was time to meet in the galley as Captain Adam went over the plans for the trip and what to expect. Next, on the plate was a beer tasting featuring IPA's from Helms Brewing Company, followed by a raffle in which 5 reels were given away as well as Seaguar Fluorocarbon for everyone. With all the festivities done for the evening it was time to hit the bunk for a good night of sleep in store for some great fishing.

Well the morning did not start off as expected as we were about 50 miles south west at grey light and making our way back up the line in search for kelp patties. We managed to get a few Yellowfin on some troll stops and scratched some more Yellowfin and Dorado in the morning. Then about 12:00pm Captain Adam got on the PA and said to bring in the trolling gear as we were approaching a kelp with good marks on the sonar. Needless to say, good marks was a slight understatement. As the baits hit the water all I could see was everyone's rod bent and Yellowfin hitting the deck at such a furious pace that the crew had a tough time keeping up with all the fish coming over the rail. Wow, what a stop! We managed to drift for 2 hours on that stop. With the boat reaching boat limit on Yellowfin, we continued looking for the next kelp patty and now the target was Dorado, in which we managed to produce about 21 Dorado. With it approaching 7:00pm and reaching boat limits, Captain Adam called it a day, and no one complained as everyone was sore and tired from a great day of fishing. We were only about 30 miles south west of San Diego so we expected to hit Mission Bay about 1:00am with an early arrival at the dock at 5:00am. I cannot say enough good things about this boat, Captain Adam, Chef Peter, the crew and owners Mark Gillette and Chris Switzer. So get ready for next year's charters. Thanks to all our anglers and guest that made this a wonderful trip. Final fish count: 120 Yellowfin, 21 Dorado and 19 Yellowtail. Jackpot winner was Cliff McClelland with a 25# Yellowfin tuna worth \$240. Congrats Cliff. Charter Master Louis Almeida, Jr.

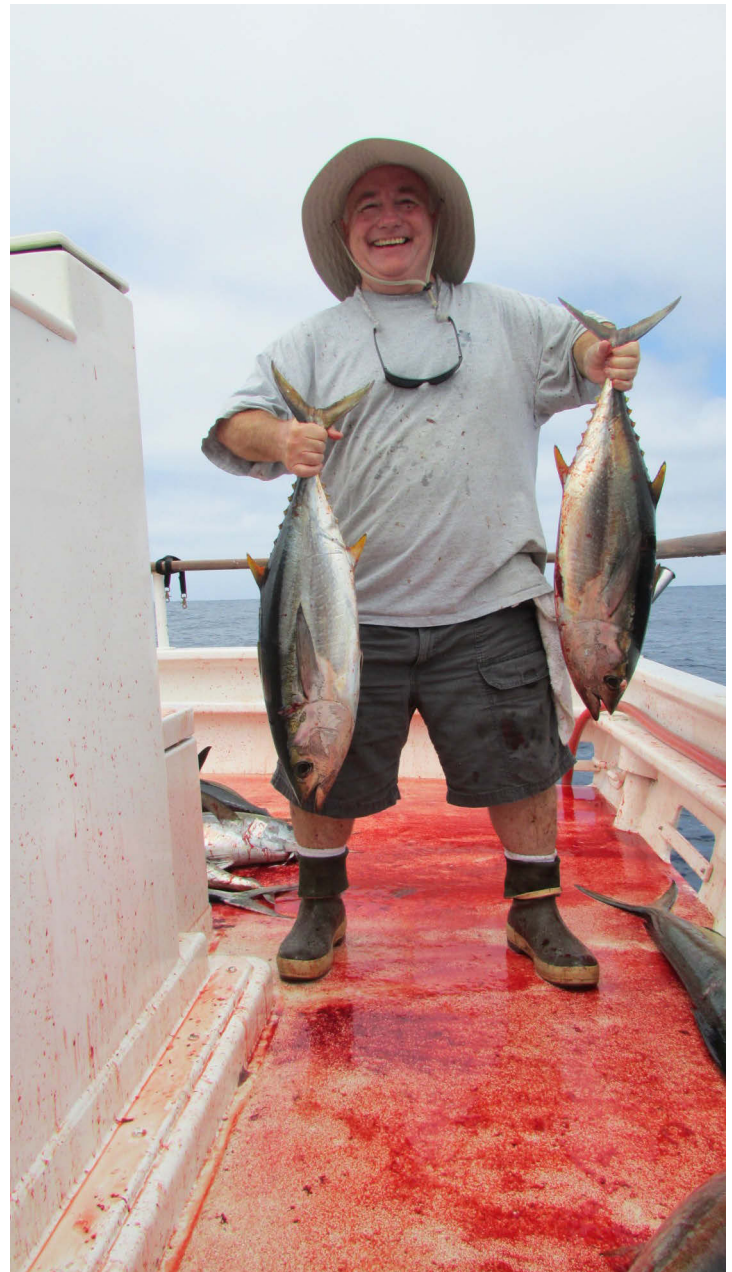

RULES AND ENTRY FORM

August 30 thru September 28, 2014

PAGE 1 OF 2

1. The official starting time of the tournament is **12:01am on Saturday, August 30, 2014**. The official ending time of the tournament is **08:00pm on Sunday, September 28, 2014**.
2. Boats may depart prior to the official starting time of the tournament. Boats must depart from and return to any port within the county of San Diego. No tournament fishing is allowed prior to the official tournament starting time.
3. **The fishing areas of the tournament shall be limited to those waters of the Pacific Ocean within 125 miles of San Diego.**
4. **During the tournament fishing can be done from any fishing platform including Sport boats.**
5. Bait may be caught, purchased or acquired as available prior to the official tournament starting time. Bait may be kept aboard tournament boats, used or transferred at the discretion of the anglers or skippers throughout the tournament.
6. California Department of Fish & Game regulations will be used for this tournament. IGFA angling rules apply, **No exceptions**. Angling rules can be found in the San Diego Anglers Yearbook under General Angling Rules. Anglers are responsible for compliance of California and Mexican, fishing and boating laws/regulations.
7. Transferring of anglers and fish from a disabled boat is allowed to comply with rule #8 or to continue to fight a hooked fish.
8. **It is the responsibility of each entrant to submit all weight receipts signed, witnessed, time/date stamped to the Club Weigh Master (Mike Sur) no later than 11:59pm September 28, 2014. Weight receipts received after this deadline will be disqualified. Weight receipts can be found on the Club website. Weight receipts can be scanned and emailed to Club Weigh Master.**
9. **Species: (All species) Excluding Sharks and Rays. All around Angler Club points system will apply for winning places leveling the playing field.** Tournament Awards will be presented at the October 1st club meeting.
10. **Cash prizes based on participation will be awarded in the following Categories: Heaviest Fish 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th and 5th place free entry for adults; 1st, 2nd and 3rd for juniors. There will be no ties in any categories. When two fish of the same weight are submitted, the first fish submitted by date and time is considered the winner.**
11. All anglers are responsible to stay aware of current weather/sea conditions. Monitor NOAA weather radio for info. The San Diego Anglers is an honorable fishing club. Entrants may sign up anytime during the tournament period prior to the ending date and time. All tournament anglers must complete, sign and submit a Tournament Entry Form prior to wetting a line in this fishing tournament and complete Boat Insurance Info on back of entry form prior to fishing the tournament and its ending date and time. The entry forms must be turned into the locations or persons listed on the back of this form. All entrants in the tournament must be current members in good standing or non-members fishing an introductory tournament as a guest of a San Diego Angler club member. Entry forms can be scanned and emailed to Tournament Director (Dave Hanes) with all pertinent signatures, boat insurance info if applicable, date and time stamp. By signing the application, applicant does assume all risks of injury or property damage, and does agree to hold the San Diego Anglers harmless should any injury, death or property damage occur.
12. Failure to comply with any of these rules will result in the offending angler's disqualification from the tournament and possible termination of club membership.
13. Tournament angler of the year points will be awarded for this tournament. There will be NO Skipper points awarded for this tournament.


