TUNA STILL ON THE CHEW

It's hard to believe that it's the 1st of December and the tuna continue to show up in the counts. Just this past weekend, the Eclipse was out on a 1.5-day fishing trip that was supposed to be a bottom fishing/Yellowtail trip. Then Captain Adam received some intel that some tuna had moved up the coast. Not wasting any time, Adam put the boat in gear in search of the tuna. And boy did they hit the jackpot. The 27 anglers on the trip were able to land 75 California Yellowtail, 270 Yellowfin Tuna, 75 Skipjack Tuna, and 15 Bluefin Tuna. The Tribute out of Seaforth landing also hit the jackpot on a trip returning the day before Thanksgiving. The managed to land 230 Yellowfin Tuna, 20 Pacific Bonito, 45 Skipjack Tuna, and 1 California Yellowtail. Two days prior they landed 320 Yellowfin Tuna, 50 Skipjack Tuna, and 6 Bluefin Tuna.

So don't put those tuna rods away yet. This upcoming storm should slow the bite down for a while, but an eye out for those tuna which may return just in time before Christmas.

MEXICO LAUNCHES NEW WEBSITE TO HELP ANGLERS

With anglers continuing to be confused by the various newly imposed regulations for fishing in Mexican waters, Mexico has launched new website that is to clarify the steps required to fish legally in its waters. The new Mexican government website should help U.S. anglers understand the requirements of the various Mexican federal agencies, including customs, fisheries and immigration.

On the website, anglers can learn rules such as Mexican customs requirements that anglers can bring up to four fishing rods into the country without paying duties. You can read about the need to pay about \$25 (USD) for a tourist visa from Mexico's National Migration Institute. It is estimated that only 25 percent of those who go fishing in Mexico do so with the proper permit. Failure to comply can result in an abrupt end to south of the border fishing trips. The new website is expected to provide information about the rules and list specific sanctions that apply for those who violate them.

ACTION ALERT:

State Plans Unlawful Raid on Fishing License Fees to Fund MPAs! Like a “Bait and Switch” scheme, the State of California wants to seize special funds generated by your fishing license fees to fund Marine Protected Areas. Guess what? Not only is it wrong, it’s illegal!

On Wednesday, December 3rd, the California Fish and Game Commission is *meeting to discuss this scheme (Agenda Item 31)*. Funds generated by fishing license fees are intended to conserve, protect and enhance fish-ing in California so that you and future generations can enjoy fishing — NOT to go into the State’s general fund and NOT to limit ocean access. The fund was designed to enhance fishing opportunities, not deny them! What’s more, if this special fund, financed by anglers, is so flush with money that it can fund MPAs, why not reduce license fees instead? Why are recreational fishermen expected to finance MPAs when commercial overfishing led to them?

Fish and Game Code Section 711(a)(1) prohibits taking monies from this special Fish and Game Preservation Fund to support non-game programs. Clearly, the Marine Life Protection Act (MLPA) (and the MPA’s created under the MLPA) is an “ecosystem” protection nongame program. *Email the Fish and Game Commission* and attend this important Commission meeting to voice your opposi-tion. Say no to the Bait and Switch! It’s bad enough that the state closed much of our State’s best ocean fishing areas to fishing. Now they want to seize your fishing license fees to fund restricted fishing areas. SAY NO to the Bait and Switch!

Pacific Bluefin Tuna Catch Limits Finalized

This week the PFMCM unanimously voted to reduce the recreational bag limit to two fish per angler per day with a maximum of six fish for multi-day trips. This is a big cut from 10 to 2, however the limit is very different from actual catch. Typically anglers catch 0-2 Bluefin and this reduction will lower actual catch by some 30%. It’s amazing to see the recreational community stepping up, taking responsibility, and giving interna-tional representatives much needed pressure on commercial fishing.

FISH FARM OFF SAN DIEGO COASTLINE IN THE WORKS

You heard right. Commercial fish pens are coming to San Diego. A partnership between Rose Canyon Fisheries and Hubbs Sea World Research Institute have teamed up to what is to become a 300,000 square-foot, 5,000 metric ton fish farm some five miles off the Mission Bay jetty. This location was chosen as it would not inter-fere with recreational anglers. The permitting process is expected to take about 18 months and Rose Canyon Fisheries still needs to raise approximately \$50 million.

DECEMBER 2014 LOBSTER HOOPING TOURNAMENT RULES AND ENTRY FORM

December 13, 2014

PAGE 1 OF 2

1. The official starting time of the tournament is **4:00pm on Saturday, December 13th, 2014**. The official ending time of the tournament is **11:00pm on Saturday, December 13th, 2014**.
2. Team Boats may depart prior to the official starting time of the tournament. Team Boats must depart from and return to Shelter Island launch ramp. No tournament Hooping is allowed prior to the official tournament starting time.
3. **The Hooping areas of the tournament shall be limited to those waters of the Pacific Ocean within 80 miles of San Diego.**
4. **During the tournament Hooping can be done from any fishing platform.**
5. Bait may be caught, purchased or acquired as available prior to the official tournament starting time. Bait may be kept aboard tournament boats, used or transferred at the discretion of the anglers or skippers throughout the tournament.
6. California Department of Fish & Game regulations will be used for this tournament. IGFA angling rules apply, **No exceptions**. Angling rules can be found in the San Diego Anglers Yearbook under General Angling Rules. Anglers are responsible for compliance of California and Mexican, fishing and boating laws/regulations.
7. Transferring of anglers and Lobster from a disabled boat is allowed to comply with rule #8 or to continue to pull a Hoop net.
8. Anglers must report in person with the Tournament Weigh master with their Lobster ready for weighing no later than the official ending time of the tournament.
9. **Species: Spinney Rock Lobster, \$30.00 Team entry fee, no limit to amount of participants making up a Team,**
10. **(\$5.00 Optional jackpot for heaviest Spider/Sheep crab). All Lobster must be weighed on the Club scale between 10:00pm & 11:00pm at the San Diego Anglers Tournament weigh station located at Outboard Motor club.**
11. **Prizes: Heaviest Three Lobster Sack 1st, 2nd and 3rd per team (Boat).** There will be no ties in any of the prize categories. When two sacks of the same weight are presented, the fish sack weighed is considered the winner.
12. All anglers are responsible to stay aware of current weather/sea conditions. Monitor NOAA weather radio for info.
13. **All tournament anglers must complete, sign and submit a Tournament Entry Form prior to wetting a Hoop in this Lobster tournament and complete Boat Insurance Info on back of entry form prior to Hooping the tournament including the policy's ending date and time. NO VERBAL ENTRIES INTO TOURNAMENT ACCEPTED.**
14. **The entry forms must be turned into the locations or persons listed on the back of this form by 12:01pm, Saturday December 13th with the Tournament Director or Fisherman's Landing Tackle Shop.** All entrants in the tournament must be current members in good standing or non-members fishing their first introductory tournament as a guest of a San Diego Angler club member. Entry forms can be scanned and emailed to Tournament Director (Dave Hanes) with all pertinent signatures, boat insurance info if applicable, date and time stamp. By signing the application, applicant does assume all risks of injury or property damage, and does agree to hold the San Diego Anglers harmless should any injury, death or property damage occur.
15. Failure to comply with any of these rules will result in the offending angler's disqualification from the tournament and possible termination of club membership.
16. **Tournament Angler, Angler of the Year and Skipper points will not be awarded for this tournament.**

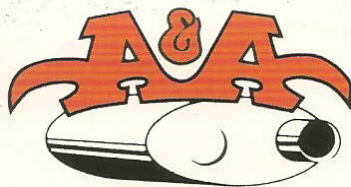
