### 2015 TOURNAMENT OF CHAMPIONS

### New "King of the Bay" is Crowned

On April 18 the club hosted its "Top 25" Tournament. We invite back the top 25 teams from the January Open Bay Bass Tournament, put \$1500 cash on the barrel head and let them go to fish San Diego Bay one more time. Each team weighs in there heaviest 3 fish sack and this years field turned in some great weights this year. As the teams weighed their 3 fish, they kept bumping off the team in the lead for the moment. The lead must have changed 5 times as the weigh in continued and when the dust settled, the team of **Joseph and Michael Isreal**, who finished in 2nd place in January's Bay Bass tournament, ended up winning with an impressive sack weighing 10.57 pounds which earned them the \$750 **First Place** prize. They also caught the largest fish of the event, a nice 5.37 pound calico which earned them the \$400 jackpot for a nice cool \$1150 payout!! **2nd Place** went to "**Mr. Second Place" this year, Ed Howerton and Nancy Ortiz** with 9.13 sack of sand bass which earned them the \$500 second place money. **3rd Place** went to one of the local legendary big fish teams on the fresh water bass side, **Brandon Buono and Dean Jamieson** weighing just behind Ed and Nancy, with 9.02 lbs of sand bass which earned them \$250. There was also a 19 lb halibut caught by Barry Chavez but



it did not count for anything in this tournament, although if they were club members and had entered the halibut tournament we were having at the same time, they would have won easily with that fish.



### MAY 2015 MONTH LONG YELLOWTAIL TOURNAMENT RULES AND ENTRY FORM

MAY 2nd thru May 31st, 2015

Tournament channel 72

#### PAGE 1 OF 2

- The official starting time of the tournament is 12:01am on Saturday, May 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2015. The official ending time of the tournament is 11:59pm on Sunday, May 31st, 2015.
- Boats may depart prior to the official starting time of the tournament. Boats must depart from and return to any port within the county of San Diego. No tournament fishing is allowed prior to the official tournament starting time.
- The fishing areas of the tournament shall be limited to those waters of the Pacific Ocean within 125 miles of San Diego.
- 4. During the tournament fishing can be done from any fishing platform including Sport boats.
- Bait may be caught, purchased or acquired as available prior to the official tournament starting time. Bait may be kept aboard tournament boats, used or transferred at the discretion of the anglers or skippers throughout the tournament.
- 6. California Department of Fish & Game regulations will be used for this tournament. IGFA angling rules apply, No exceptions. Angling rules can be found in the San Diego Anglers Yearbook under General Angling Rules. Anglers are responsible for compliance of California and Mexican, fishing and boating laws/regulations.
- 7. Transferring of anglers and fish from a disabled boat is allowed to comply with rule #8 or to continue to fight a hooked fish.
- 8. It is the responsibility of each entrant to submit all weight receipts signed, witnessed, time/date stamped to the Club Weigh Master (Mike Sur) no later than 11:59pm May 31st, 2015. Weight receipts received after this deadline will be disqualified. Weight receipts can be found on the Club website. Weight receipts can be scanned and emailed to Club Weigh Master.
- Species: Yellowtail. Tournament Awards will be presented at the June 3<sup>rd</sup> monthly club meeting.
   Prizes verses cash will be awarded in the following Categories: Heaviest Yellowtail 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> place for adults; 1st, 2nd and 3rd for juniors. There will be no ties in any categories. When two fish of the same weight are submitted, the first fish submitted by date and time is considered the winner.
- 11. All anglers are responsible to stay aware of current weather/sea conditions. Monitor NOAA weather radio for info.
- 12. The San Diego Anglers is an honorable fishing club. Entrants may sign up anytime during the tournament period prior to the ending date and time. All tournament anglers must complete, sign and submit a Tournament Entry Form prior to wetting a line in this fishing tournament and complete Boat Insurance Info on back of entry form prior to fishing the tournament and its ending date and time. The entry forms must be turned into the locations or persons listed on the back of this form. All entrants in the tournament must be current members in good standing or non-members fishing an introductory tournament as a guest of a San Diego Angler club member. Entry forms can be scanned and emailed to Tournament Director (Alan Branch) Branch2fish@gmail.com with all pertinent signatures, boat insurance info if applicable, date and time stamp. By signing the application, applicant does assume all risks of injury or property damage, and does agree to hold the San Diego Anglers harmless should any injury, death or property damage occur.
- 13. Failure to comply with any of these rules will result in the offending angler's disqualification from the tournament and possible termination of club membership.
- 14. Tournament angler of the year points will be awarded for this tournament. There will be NO Skipper points awarded for this tournament.

### ALL ENTRANTS MUST BE MEMBERS OF THE SAN DIEGO ANGLERS IN GOOD STANDING.
