Besides being an avid fisherman, he is also the author of not one but three books, *The Southern California Angler*, *Getting Bit* and *The Local Angler*. And let's not forget his recent writing, *The Bight – A Journal for the Saltwater Angler*. Plus Brandon is into his forth season as the owner/operator/guide of One Man Charters, offering fishing charters on 23 foot Parker specializing in fishing for White Seabass, Halibut, Yellowtail, and basically anything else that swims in the ocean. In 2013 his clients had 50+ White Seabass over 50 lbs. and nine over 60 lbs., all in local waters. But he also offers offshore and island trips to Catalina and San Clemente. He is the master at catching the 50 to 60-plus pound White Seabass. He also holds a 100-ton Master's License from the United States Coast Guard and has spent over 1,000 days working on San Diego sportboats like the Excel, Pacific Queen, First String and Producer before starting his career as an outdoor writer.

This was our final Twilight trip for 2015. Friday evening at 5pm, nearly 65 San Diego Anglers and their guests loaded on to the New Seaforth out of Seaforth Sportfishing. It was a beautiful evening with a great sunset, sorry no green flash tonight. We mainly fished for bass in the kelp beds off La Jolla with mini macks, sardines, and of course squid strips. We got a number of Calico Bass, a couple of Sand Bass, Barracuda... but the big catch was when we thought Will Bowen had hung a... Tuna? White Sea Bass? Yellowtail? Lots of speculating as he really worked to pull his trophy up on a light rod and reel. Finally the fish came to gaff, a ~23Lb Yellowtail caught on a squid strip on the bottom! Lots of kids on board tonight and our Junior winners were: in first place was Wyatt Kirkendall, Colin Gleaves in 2nd place, and our guest Tegan took 3rd place! Be sure to see these future fishing stars receive their awards at our September meeting. Our next set of Twilight Trips will be starting in May 2016 so keep a look out.



2015 CHARTERS

$\frac{3}{4}$ Day Charters **WOW**, where has the fishing year gone to?? We are winding down our charters for the year and all that remain are our two $\frac{3}{4}$ day charters on the Vendetta (Friday, Sept 11) and the San Diego (Sunday, Sept 13). They look like we might hit the fishing at a GREAT time. YFT, Dorado, yellowtail and they even saw a wahoo last Friday on a kelp pattie off the 302!!

If you have signed up for them, we need to have them paid at the Sept meeting. I am pretty sure that the Vendetta is sold out (Talk to Louis about that one) but the San Diego might have one spot left. The Cost of the limited load (30) "San Diego" trip is \$125 plus permits if necessary (Mex lic and /or Mex Tourist Card). You must have a passport or passport card to fish the trip. There is a good possibility that we might fish the islands if the excellent yellowtail fishing continues there. Please be sure to bring your passport or passport card that morning or they won't allow you to get on the boat.

New 3/4 Day Charter

Since we had so much fun on the last one, (Limits of Yellowtail!) we have chartered the 3/4 day boat San Diego again for another 3/4 day trip. The date is Sunday, September 13 and You must have a passport or a passport card to fish this trip. The cost of the trip is the same, \$125 for the basic trip. If we need to get FMM's (Mexican Tourist Cards) to fish the islands, that will be an extra \$25 the morning of the trip. But now we have a new wrinkle, which is good. If the tuna are biting and they are close, we will go after them. Because it will take more fuel for the day, there will be a \$10 per person fuel charge before we get on the trip but, because we will be outside the 12 mile limit required for the FMM tourist card, you won't need to purchase the \$25 FMM !! But, we won't know until the evening before on what we are doing as far as tuna or the Coronados.

I will have the sign up sheet at the next meeting. If you think you want to go on the trip, please bring your deposit to the meeting. It is a very popular trip so if you are serious, please come prepared because it will sell out!!

SUCCESS CHARTER

The Sportfishing Landings were all excited as hundreds of people were vying for the precious few parking spots, even though it was a Sunday evening. The fish had been biting and the 11 of us boarded the Success with dreams of big tuna jumping in the boat. Then I got a call from Carey (Owner/ Skipper) that he was down with the flu bad and would not be able to make it. Plan "B" went into effect as the crew scrambled to get the boat ready for our departure. We grabbed our sardines and off we went. We woke up in the morning on the Mackerel Bank, which is just inside San Clemente Island at the north end. We caught a small tuna in the dark but were looking for something bigger, so we moved on and it wasn't long before we found a meter mark. Out went the baits and a few of us hooked up with some really nice yellowfin. The bite slowed and we stuck with the area for about 3 or 4 hours for nothing more. The rest of the boats started looking and we followed shortly. We found tons of kelps, but nothing was under them. We started finding lots of tern bird flocks as we headed west and run over to every one, but could not get the tuna to stay up and bite the bait. It was like chasing butterflies as the terns moved, disappeared and reappeared a half a mile to the west. Finally as the sun was going down, we found one school that wanted to play and we caught tuna into the dark. They finally stopped and when we looked at our bait situation, we decided to head back to San Diego bay and get some more. After re-baiting we headed out to the fishing grounds for day two and awoke to beautiful conditions. We again chased tern flocks and found a few fish that wanted to stay up and play throughout the day. Reluctantly, we had to head in as we were out of time by mid afternoon. When the dust settled, we ended up with about 60 yellowfin tuna to about 40 lbs.



SDA Vendetta Charter

August 28th

Well the second of the third club charters aboard the Vendetta took off early Friday morning for the fishing grounds hoping to catch some Bluefin and/or Yellowfin tuna. Unfortunately, the tuna gods were not on our side that day. What started out on a good note, with the first two stops on kelp producing some nice Dorado, we thought we were sure to get our limits quickly, but no luck. After a first few stops on kelp, we spent the remainder of the day trolling and stopping on a number of kelps, but no one was home. Well that's fishing. You could not asked for better fishing conditions. The water was warm and the seas were calm all day. Final count: 12 anglers for 14 Dorado. Jim Johnson took the honors with the largest Dorado



taken on the troll. The next Vendetta charter is Friday, September 11th. Again this is limited to 12 anglers. Trip will be a combo trip, meaning we will fish inshore at the Coronado Islands first thing in the morning, and then head offshore to look for some tuna and Dorado. You will need a passport to fish this charter. Cost is \$200 for the charter, plus \$25 for the FMM. You must also have a Mexican and California fishing license.

September 1 thru October 4, 2015

1. The official starting time of the tournament is 12:01am on Tuesday, September 1, 2015. The official ending time of the tournament is 08:00pm on Sunday, October 4, 2015.
2. Boats may depart prior to the official starting time of the tournament. Boats must depart from and return to any port within the county of San Diego. No tournament fishing is allowed prior to the official tournament starting time.
3. The fishing areas of the tournament shall be limited to those waters of the Pacific Ocean within 125 miles of San Diego.
4. During the tournament fishing can be done from any fishing platform including Sport boats.
5. Bait may be caught, purchased or acquired as available prior to the official tournament starting time. Bait may be kept aboard tournament boats, used or transferred at the discretion of the anglers or skippers throughout the tournament.
6. California Department of Fish & Game regulations will be used for this tournament. IGFA angling rules apply, No exceptions. Angling rules can be found in the San Diego Anglers Yearbook under General Angling Rules. Anglers are responsible for compliance of California and Mexican, fishing and boating laws/regulations.
7. Transferring of anglers and fish from a disabled boat is allowed to comply with rule #8 or to continue to fight a hooked fish.
8. It is the responsibility of each entrant to submit all weight receipts signed, witnessed, time/date stamped to the Club Weigh Master (Mike Sur) no later than 11:59pm October 4, 2015. Weight receipts received after this deadline will be disqualified. Weight receipts can be found on the Club website. Weight receipts can be scanned and emailed to Club Weigh Master.
9. Species: (All species) Excluding Sharks and Rays. All around Angler Club points system will apply for winning places leveling the playing field. Tournament Awards will be presented at the October 7th club meeting.
10. Cash prizes based on participation will be awarded in the following Categories: Heaviest Fish 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th and 5th place free entry for adults; 1st, 2nd and 3rd for juniors. There will be no ties in any categories. When two fish of the same weight are submitted, the first fish submitted by date and time is considered the winner.
11. All anglers are responsible to stay aware of current weather/sea conditions. Monitor NOAA weather radio for info. The San Diego Anglers is an honorable fishing club. Entrants may sign up anytime during the tournament period prior to the ending date and time. All tournament anglers must complete, sign and submit a Tournament Entry Form prior to wetting a line in this fishing tournament and complete Boat Insurance Info on back of entry form prior to fishing the tournament and its ending date and time. The entry forms must be turned into the locations or persons listed on the back of this form. All entrants in the tournament must be current members in good standing or non-members fishing an introductory tournament as a guest of a San Diego Angler club member. Entry forms can be scanned and emailed to Tournament Director (Alan Branch) with all pertinent signatures, boat insurance info if applicable, date and time stamp. By signing the application, applicant does assume all risks of injury or property damage, and does agree to hold the San Diego Anglers harmless should any injury, death or property damage occur.
12. Failure to comply with any of these rules will result in the offending angler's disqualification from the tournament and possible termination of club membership.
13. Tournament angler of the year points will be awarded for this tournament. There will be NO Skipper points awarded for this tournament.

There will be no barbeque after tournament.
