

San Diego Anglers 2020 Open Bay Bass Tourney

We finally got the 23rd Annual Open Bay Bass Tournament in the books, but not before another weather scare. The possibility of heavy fog was predicted for tournament morning, and that can delay the start of the tournament until the fog lifts. UGH! But the weather gods were smiling on us that morning and we ended up with 117 vessels starting in beautiful, clear weather that morning. Fishing was a little tough for keepers this year (heard there were plenty of 13 3/4 in bass though!) and when the dust settled, we had a new team win the event this year. Congratulations to Bryan Davis and Whitney Uyeda for winning this year's event! They weighed 3 big sand bass for 10.43 pounds topped by a nice 5pounder, worth \$250 sponsored by Seaforth Boat Rentals, their first-place effort of \$1500 (Fishermans Landing Tackle), and they also won the jackpot of \$1,450! WOW. Not bad for a day of bay fishing. Rumor was they caught their fish on Ring Hammer made by Big Hammer lures. Second place went to a past winner, Mike and Andrew Hill, with 10.16 pounds. (\$750 from Costa Sunglasses). Third went to last year's Bay Bass Invitational last April winners, Brandon Buono and Dean Jamieson, with 9.93 pounds. (All 3 teams also walked away with Daiwa Lexa 300 reels with matching rods.) It looks like the top 3 winners were within 1/2 pound of each other, one of the closest finishes we have had in a long time.

On the Kayak side, we had Mark Kleiter win again, for the second year in a row, with a sack of 3.25 pounds, taking the \$500 sponsored by Fast Lane Kayaks. Congratulations on your back-to-

back wins!!!!

We would like to thank our top sponsors Tow Boat U.S., Penske Ford, Fast Lane Kayaks and Fisherman's Landing Tackle for making it happen again. We had about 50 sponsors this year, and we would like to thank each and every one of them again for helping to make this event a very memorable one.



Captain Pelican Phil's Killer Greek Style Seared Fish With Couscous



Ingredients:

- (4) 6 to 7 ounces of firm white flesh fish, dorado, ono, yellowtail, sheep's, or halibut works great too!
- 1/2 cup flour
- 5 tablespoons of olive oil (divided)
- 2 shallots, chopped fine
- 1/4 to 1/2 teaspoon of dried red chili flakes 1/3 cup of pitted kalamata olives (chopped)
- 3 fresh roma tomatoes (seeded and chopped)
- 1/2 cup of fresh basil (chopped and divided) 1 tablespoon of capers (drained and chopped in half)
- 1/2 cup of good white wine
- 1/3 cup of clam juice

Recipe as follows:

Heat half of the olive oil in frying pan, salt and pepper fish well and dredge in flour and fry for 4 minutes a side then place on paper towels. Next place the rest of the olive oil in pan and add the shallots and chili flakes and sauté for about 1-1/2 to 2 minutes (careful not to burn) and then add the olives, tomatoes, basil, capers, wine and clam juice and simmer for about 3 to 4 minutes or until reduced. Season veggie sauce with salt and pepper to taste and place over fish, also, this goes great over a bed of couscous (Near East in the rice section works well).

- The official starting time of the tournament is 06:00 am on Saturday, February 22nd, 2020. The official ending time of the tournament is 3:00 pm on Saturday, February 22nd, 2020.
- Boats may depart prior to the official starting time of the tournament. Boats must depart from and return to any port within the county of San Diego. No tournament fishing is allowed prior to the official tournament starting time. All club tournaments are operated on an honor system.
- The fishing areas of the tournament shall be in MISSION BAY (Drawing an Imaginary line between the entrance/exit jetties). No fishing within 100ft of Bait Barge.
- 4. During the tournament, fishing can be done from any fishing platform, including Sportfishing boats.
- Bait may be caught, purchased or acquired as available prior to the official tournament starting time. Bait may be kept aboard tournament boats, used or transferred at the discretion of the anglers or skippers throughout the tournament.
- IGFA angling rules will be used for this tournament. Angling rules can be found in the San Diego Anglers Yearbook under General Angling Rules. Anglers are responsible for compliance with all California or Mexican fishing and boating laws and regulations, as applicable.
- All fish must be weighed on the club scale between 2:00 PM and 3:00 PM at the San Diego Anglers Tournament Weigh Station located at the SOUTH SHORES LAUNCH RAMP in Mission Bay.
- Eligible Species: <u>Calico Bass. Sand Bass. & Spotted Bav Bass</u>. Entrants can weigh up to three (3) total fish from any combination of the eligible species (3-fish sack).
- Prizes will be awarded in the following Categories: <u>Heaviest Sack Weight</u> 1st, 2nd, 3nd, 4th and 5th place for open division; 1st, 2nd and 3rd for women; and 1st, 2nd and 3rd for juniors. There will be no ties in any category. When two sacks of the same weight are submitted, the first sack submitted is considered the winner.
- 10. Jackpot: There will be a \$10.00 optional Jackpot for the heaviest single bass.
- 11. All anglers are responsible to stay aware of current weather/sea conditions. Monitor NOAA weather radio for info.
- 12. All tournament anglers must complete, sign and submit a <u>Tournament Entry Form</u> and a <u>COPY OF THEIR CURRENT BOAT INSURANCE POLICY</u> prior to wetting a line in this fishing tournament. Entrants may sign up anytime prior to the tournament starting date and time. The entry forms must be turned in to the locations or persons listed on the back of this form. All entrants in the tournament must be current members in good standing or non-members fishing as a guest of a club member. Entry forms can be scanned and emailed to Tournament Director with all pertinent signatures, boat insurance info (if applicable), and date/time stamp. By signing the application, applicant does assume all risks of injury or property damage, and does agree to hold the San Diego Anglers harmless should any injury, death or property damage occur.
- Failure to comply with any of these rules will result in the offending angler's disqualification from the tournament and
 possible termination of club membership.
- 14. Tournament Angler of the Year and Skipper points will be awarded for this tournament.
