Following is the list of the charters so you can put them on your schedule. I am not taking names or reservations yet as we still have a ways to go for the first charter in May. I think I am going to do what I did last year, as it made it very easy for myself and Earl, God rest his soul, and only take names for each charter as they come up on the schedule. I will collect the names and money, go fishing and make the deposit after the charter. The bookkeeping was a lot of work the way we did it before.

****On "Vendetta" trips ONLY** to the Islands: Price includes food, drinks, FMM, Biosphere bracelet. **IT DOES NOT** include Mexican Fishing license. You must purchase that separately. All other boat Island charters, these costs are extra. **12 passengers max**.

On Twilight trips: All are on Friday evenings. Cost is \$20 for adults, kids 16 and under are FREE. Limited to **42 passengers and club members only at this point in CoVid, although things might change.

To Sign Up for the charters: As the next trip approaches, I will send out an email requesting sign-ups and payments. **BE SURE** that your email address is on the club's GMail account. **If it is not, PLEASE** send me a personal email so I can add it to the list.
