- 1. The official starting time of the tournament is 06:00 am on Sunday, August 1, 2021. The official ending time of the tournament is 5:00 pm on Sunday, September 26, 2021. THIS WILL BE A FORK MEASURMENT RULE TOURNAMENT.
- Boats may depart prior to the official starting time of the tournament. Boats must depart from and return to any port within the county of San Diego. No tournament fishing is allowed prior to the official tournament starting time. All club tournaments are operated on an honor system.
- 3. The fishing areas of the tournament shall be limited to those waters of the Pacific Ocean within 125 miles of San Diego.
- 4. During the tournament, fishing can be done from any fishing platform, including kayaks, private or sportfishing boats.
- 5. Bait may be caught, purchased, or acquired as available prior to the official tournament starting time. Bait may be kept aboard tournament boats, used, or transferred at the discretion of the anglers or skippers throughout the tournament.
- 6. IGFA angling rules will be used for this tournament. Angling rules can be found in the San Diego Anglers Yearbook under General Angling Rules. Anglers are responsible for compliance with all California or Mexican fishing and boating laws and regulations, as applicable.
- 7. All fish entries photo must be e-mailed to <a href="mailed-to-lindsevsi@aol.com">lindsevsi@aol.com</a> with an email date/time of no later than 6:00 PM, Sunday, September 26, 2021. Late entries will not be accepted. There must be 2 photos per fish:
  - First Photo: Shall show the whole fish and the anglers name printed legibly with the measuring device across the side of the fish. So as the see the overall length of the fish.
  - Second Photo: Shall be of the same fish, this time of the "Y" of tail section of the fish so as to be able to read the length of the fish to the nearest 1/8".
  - Photos that are not in focus enough to be properly read will not be accepted. You will be notified as soon as the photos are reviewed if they are not acceptable.
- 8. Eligible Species: Tuna (Yellow or Blue fin), Dorado, and Yellowtail. Entrants can submit multiple submittals, only the largest single fish of each specie will be counted for that angler.
- 9. Prizes will be awarded in the following categories: **Tuna Class, Dorado Class, Yellowtail Class** 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> place for adults; 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> for juniors. There will be no ties in any category. When two entries of the same length are submitted, the first fish submitted (based on the date time stamp on the email) will be considered the winner.
- 10. <u>Bonus Class</u>: There will be <u>NO additional fee</u> for this Bonus Class. It will be based on a 3-fish sack for total overall length. All anglers entered in the tournament (Adults & Juniors) with a 3-fish sack will automatically be entered in the Bonus Class.
- 11. Tournament awards will be presented at the CLUB BBQ / Earl Asbury Memorial salute on October 3, 2021
- 12. All anglers are responsible to stay aware of current weather/sea conditions. Monitor NOAA weather radio for info.
- 13. All tournament anglers must complete, sign, and submit a <u>Tournament Entry Form</u> and a <u>COPY OF THEIR CURRENT BOAT INSURANCE POLICY</u> prior to wetting a line in this fishing tournament. Entrants may sign up any time prior to the tournament starting date and time. The entry forms must be turned in to the locations or persons listed on the back of this form. All entrants in the tournament must be current members in good standing or non-members fishing as a guest of a club member. Entry forms can be scanned and emailed to Tournament Director with all pertinent signatures, boat insurance info (if applicable), and date/time stamp. By signing the application, Applicant does assume all risks of injury or property damage and does agree to hold the San Diego Anglers harmless should any injury, death or property damage occur.
- 14. Failure to comply with any of these rules will result in the offending angler's disqualification from the tournament and possible termination of club membership.
- 15. Tournament Angler of the Year and Skipper points will be awarded for this tournament based on class results.

Any protest relative to the length/weight of a fish, manner of measuring/weighing, or the manner of catching/landing the fish must be made prior to the notification of placement in the tournament or the fish being removed from the scale. The protest must be made to the Tournament Weighmaster and Tournament Director at that time.
- 4. Any protest, except weight, must be filed in writing with the Protest Committee no later than 24 hours after the ending time of the tournament. The protest may be filed with any member of the Protest Committee.
- 5. The San Diego Anglers take no responsibility for personal injury, death, or property damage resulting from any misconduct, negligence, and adverse weather conditions or otherwise, of any persons or its members at sponsored events and tournaments.
- 6. The San Diego Anglers does not investigate weather or sea conditions, or the possibility of other boating activities, when scheduling its events.
- 7. By signing this application, the applicant assumes all risks of injury, death, or property damage, and agrees to hold the San Diego Anglers harmless should any injury or damage occur.

## Earl Asbury Memorial Tournament Measurement Rule Information


The 2021 Earl Asbury Memorial Tournament will be an 8-week event under the SDA Measurement Rule.

- All anglers MUST BE signed up PROIR TO FISHING. All entry forms must be sent in before 6:00 AM the date of the event
- All fish MUST BE of legal size to be scored, <u>even if the fish is released</u>. The fish must be photographed against the measuring device as depicted in the diagram below.
- All fish must be measured the same way: with the fish lying on its side, on a flat surface. The '0' end of the soft tape at the nose/closed mouth of the fish. The soft tape measure shall be pulled taut (No wrinkles) and run the side centerline of the fish to the "Y" of the tail.
- The **photos** of the catch MUST BE IN FOCUS. **First Photo** shall show the whole fish, with a clear view of the zero end of the tape is on the nose/closed mouth and where the soft tape measure comes to on the "Y" of the tail and the Angler's Name. The Angler's Name may be written on an index card or the back of your hand, either way it must be legible. **Second Photo** shall be of the "Y" of the tail so as to be able to easily read the soft tape measuring device to the nearest 1/8".
- The Photos and Measurement Rule Tournament Fish Report form (Fill out completely for <u>each species</u> being entered. Example: Three species, three forms and 6 photos) must be e-mailed to <u>lindseysj@aol.com</u> before the closing deadline, 6:00 PM on Sunday, September 26, 2021.

All length will be determined/confirmed by the tournament director based on photo sent in.

#### HOW TO MEASURE FORK LENGTH OF CATCH

The **total length** is the maximum length of the fish, from the nose/closed mouth to the "Y" of the tail. With the fish laying on its side, on a flat surface, Place the Zero end of a soft tape measure at the nose/closed mouth. Pull a flexible tape taut (no wrinkles), measure along the side centerline/curve of the fish to the farthest section of "Y" of the tail.
