He found a few Bluefin biting along the way and we hooked probably 10. Continuing Southwest, Alisa hooked a dorado on the troll, which she landed. Several casts into a small kelp patty landed various anglers 3 more. Matt continued to find Yellowfin Tuna biting, picky, but somewhat steady. Everyone would hook up at once, a lot of tangles and lost fish. When it was about 3pm and time to head back, he turned the boat around and ran into a large biting school of Yellowfin. We had a chaotic 1.5 hours of pulling in fish, nice - size, 31-34 lbs. Most of us landed 2-3 each on this trip. Long ride, 4 hours, back to the dock, with us arriving at 9PM. Matt worked extra hard for us, allowing us to stay in the fishing grounds much longer than expected. The crew was excellent, and everyone went home with fish. Overall we caught approx. 90 fish, mixed Bluefin & Yellowfin Tuna. It was an exceptional day with 30 anglers onboard. Good to see our friends and catch up.






















Wounded Warriors Islands Trip

We were going to the Islands, to look for yellowtail, bass, bonito and anything else that wanted to bite. Chad and Tim from Hookup Baits busted out the huge box of lures and we started tying them on the loaner spinning rods. By the time we got to the islands we were ready to go. I was in the wheelhouse with Capt. Anibal, and he started searching for yellows. We made a few stops, catching huge bonito and calico bass pretty much at every stop. As the boat searched around all the islands, it was obvious there were no yellowtail at the islands. I told him we would be stoked with calicos, so that is what he concentrated on.

The Calico fishing was pretty incredible that day. Everyone got lessons on how to fish them. "Don't Blink on the Sink" was echoed throughout the morning as the warriors soon learned that the calicos were on the bottom and you just had to let the lure get close to the bottom and you had a bass. By noon, the volunteers that had joined us could not hand off a fish anymore as our guests had figured it out and were having a blast with the Hook Up Baits. By the end of the day, I am pretty sure that everyone had a limit of fish to bring home to eat. We did catch 2 yellowtail at the middle grounds at the end of the day and those soldiers were pretty stoked, to say the least! The deckhands started cleaning the bass and rockfish when we hit the border line, and we ended having to sit in San Diego Bay to finish cleaning as we made it back to Point Loma pretty fast.

We had a very special guest on board to join us from the Marine Corps, Col Willard Buhl. His accomplishments are as long as your leg, but he is very proud of his service in the "Thundering Third," Third Battalion, First Marines, in the clearing of Fallujah, Iraq during Operation Iraqi Freedom. He had a lot of great stories to tell us as we traveled between spots. I cannot even imagine how much guts it takes to go door to door to clear the insurgents from the city in a 2-year span. He knew exactly how many Marines he lost in that endeavor and many of their names and stories. As a Marine he was an expert and he was eager to learn this new endeavor we call fishing, and by the end of the day, he had it down pretty well and was jacking the bass in the boat pretty fast. It was an honor to meet a legend in the Marine Corp. He told us how important these fishing trips are to their well being. He was pretty happy his guys all had smiles on their faces throughout the day. He thanked us many times for our service to help the wounded warriors!

I would like to thank the sponsors that made this trip happen: Ralph from Penske Ford in La Mesa, Josh from Miller Toyota in Anaheim for chartering the trip for the guys, Chad and JoJo from Hookup Baits for supplying all the lures that day, and Dave McMullen with Ocean Science International. It ended up being another fantastic trip for the Wounded Warriors

and we can not wait to raise more money and get a schedule

for next year!

The San Diego Anglers only accepts this online weight receipt or the official paper version of the San Diego Anglers Official Weight Receipt. No other weight receipts from other clubs are acceptable. 

November 2021 BASS SLAM TOURNAMENT RULES AND ENTRY FORM

Saturday, November 6th, 2021



The official starting time of the tournament is 6:00 AM on Saturday, November 6th, 2021. The official ending time of the tournament is 4:00 PM on Saturday, October 17th, 2020. THIS WILL BE A LIVE WEIGH IN TOURNAMENT.

NOTE: All State and County COVID-19 Directives must be adhered to.

- 1. Boats may depart prior to the official starting time of the tournament. Boats must depart from and return to any port within the county of San Diego. No tournament fishing is allowed prior to the official tournament starting time. All club tournaments are operated on an honor system
- 2. The fishing areas of the tournament shall be limited to those waters of the Pacific Ocean within 125 miles of San Diego.
- 3. During the tournament, fishing can be done from any fishing platform, including Sportfishing boats.
- 4. Bait may be caught, purchased, or acquired as available prior to the official tournament starting time. Bait may be kept aboard tournament boats, used, or transferred at the discretion of the anglers or skippers throughout the tournament.
- 5. IGFA angling rules will be used for this tournament. Angling rules can be found in the San Diego Anglers Yearbook under General Angling Rules. Anglers are responsible for compliance with all California or Mexican fishing and boating laws and regulations, as applicable.
- 6. All fish must be weighed in on the Club Scale between 3:00 PM and 4:00 PM at the San Diego Anglers Tournament Weigh Station at the SHELTER ISLAND BOAT LAUNCH RAMP on San Diego Bay.
- 7. Eligible Species: Calico Bass, Sand Bass, and Spotted Bay Bass. Entrants can weigh in only one fish from each species, the day of day of tournament. Only your heaviest fish of each species will count toward your 3 fish sack, with only one sack per registered angler.
- 8. Prizes will be awarded in the following categories: **Heaviest Sack Weight** 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th and 5th place for adults; 1st, 2nd and 3rd for all junior classes. Regardless of weight, 3 Bass sack beats a 2 Bass Sack and a 2 Bass Sack beats a 1 Bass Sack. There will be no ties in any category. When two sacks of the same weight are submitted, the first sack submitted is considered the winner. Tournament awards will be presented at the NEXT club meeting.
- 9. Jackpot: There will be a \$10.00 optional Jackpot for the LARGEST single fish from any of the eligible Bass species.
- 10. All anglers are responsible to stay aware current weather/sea conditions. Monitor NOAA weather radio for info.
- 11. All tournament anglers must complete, sign and submit a <u>Tournament Entry Form</u> and a <u>COPY OF THEIR CURRENT BOAT INSURANCE POLICY</u> prior to wetting a line in this fishing tournament. Entrants may sign up any time prior to the tournament starting date and time. The entry forms must be turned in to the locations or persons listed on the back of this form. All entrants in the tournament must be current members in good standing or non-members fishing as a guest of a club member. Entry forms can be scanned and emailed to Tournament Director with all pertinent signatures, boat insurance info (if applicable), and date/time stamp. By signing the application, applicant does assume all risks of injury or property damage, and does agree to hold the San Diego Anglers harmless should any injury, death or property damage occur.
- 12. Failure to comply with any of these rules will result in the offending angler's disqualification from the tournament and possible termination of club membership.
- 13. Tournament Angler of the Year and Skipper points will be awarded for this tournament.
